The Residency Inclusion, Cultural Humility, Diversity and Equity (INCLUDE) curriculum, developed in 2017, covers cultural humility, the historical context of racism in medicine, addressing microaggressions, health care equity, traumainformed care, LGBTIQ+ health, religion in medicine, immigration law, and other topics.







This residency track's mission is to train a diverse group of pediatric residents to advance health equity for children and adolescents through collaborative clinical care, community partnership, advocacy, and education.






